ORANGE = Very busy juggling many responsibilities. Have had to make difficult decisions on what to prioritize.



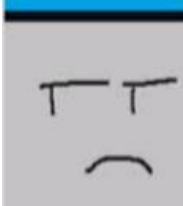
YELLOW = Busy. Lots of things to do but managing okay. Have some ability to look beyond what is needed today.

This is not a simple task we can do alone.

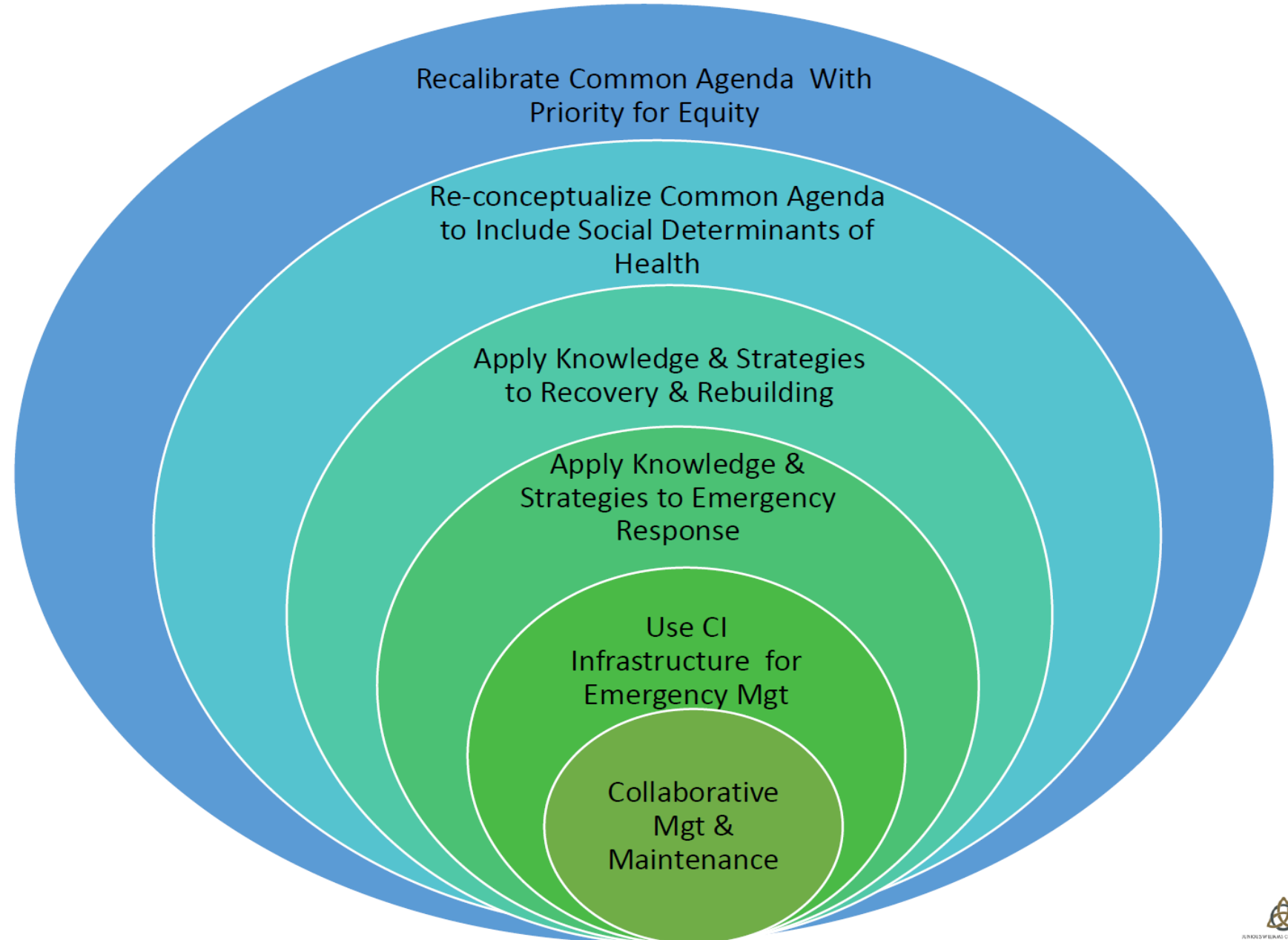

REVIEW OF FOCUS AREAS & LOOKING AHEAD

Strategies and Activities

1. Standardize intake and screening protocols across care settings

- **1.1 Create a curated list of screening tools and protocols**
- **1.2 Identify and implement a standardized intake form and protocol across care systems**
- 1.3 Conduct cross disciplinary training to establish common approaches
- 1.4 Identify performance outcome measures

2. Standardize transition of care protocols between care systems and levels of care

- 2.1 Identify and document break-down areas during care transitions among hospitals, clinics, and providers
- 2.2 Develop recommendations for hospitals, providers, etc. to adopt to streamline and improve care transitions
- **2.3 Create and pilot with a sub-set of organizations a universal data sharing agreement**
- 2.4 Develop cross organizational workflows and trainings to establish more streamlined care transitions

3. Expand BH provider network and expertise of MH and SUD workforce

- 3.1 Explore performance-based contracting with providers, including community defined values and metrics
- 3.2 Explore development of a public/private provider network
- 3.3 Streamline the process of becoming an in-network provider
